GREENE COUNTY COMBINED HEALTH DISTRICT HEALTH COMMISSIONER'S REPORT May 1, 2015

- 1. Accreditation/Assessment (Sheryl Wynn)
 - a. Melissa Howell completed the first draft of the strategic plan.
 - b. 04/10/15 Community Wide Needs Assessment final phase survey for the general public has been reviewed. Worked with Don Brannen, PhD, and Meg Gillis of United Way to capture the group's edits and revise the survey. The online survey is designed to capture citizens who use services and to get feedback from community members who do not use services.
- 2. Administration and Administrative Services (Melissa Howell)
 - a. 04/10/15 Met with John Poe Architects to discuss program requirements for new facility at existing location.
 - b. 04/10/15 Phone service disrupted due to a lightning strike and system had to be replaced. We were able to use cell phone service and deliver messages to staff using pen and paper. Service was restored on 04/14/15.
 - c. 04/16/15 Met with Greene/Soin executive council to discuss helipad.
 - d. Reviewed applicants to Wright State University's Master of Public Health Program.
- 3. Community Health Services (Robyn Fosnaugh)
 - a. Dental: Training for the electronic dental record is complete.

 - c. Reproductive Health and Wellness Grant: First quarter claims have been submitted utilizing the Electronic Medical Record System (EMR).
- 4. Emergency Preparedness (Sheryl Wynn)
 - a. 04/06/15 Review and evaluation of Medical Countermeasures software from CDC.
- 5. Environmental Health (Debbie Leopold)
 - a. On April 8, 2015, the health district responded to a request by the Jefferson Township Department to assist with a wind damaged structure located at 5694 West Xenia Street, Bowersville. The investigation revealed the structure was unsafe and declared a public health nuisance. The health district provided the funding to secure the structure to remove any immediate health and safety concerns. The State of Ohio Building Division was notified and a structural inspector visited the site on April 23, 2015, a copy of the report is forthcoming. Please see the enclosed information.
 - b. The health district received a complaint via the website at 9:25 p.m., on April 21, 2015, regarding an individual finding a fingernail in a Taco Bell Mexican pizza. The complaint could not be verified as facility management reported that the staff was wearing gloves as appropriate. The investigating sanitarian reviewed with the store manager proper glove use and assuring that employees are following the glove use guidelines set forth in the Ohio Food Code at all times. Complaint was closed after follow-up with the complainant. The health district responded to several media outlets concerning the matter.
 - c. The community event season is upon us and with the changing of the weather the



health district is seeing the beginning of increased temporary food events. From the Central State University Spring Fest, International Friendship Event, Taste of Greene, Sugar Maple Festival, and the newest event this month was the Dayton Food Truck Rally held at *The Greene* on April 17 was a success. All temporary food events require sanitarians to inspect food operations.

- d. On April 14, 2015, staff made a follow-up inspection at 1966 North Boulevard, Fairborn, to check the clean-up of the property that was declared a public health nuisance. The matter is being referred to Stephanie Hayden, Assistant Prosecuting Attorney for enforcement.
- e. Shadrick Adams and Donald Shontz are now licensed pest control applicators to provide services in the Mosquito Control Program. The program has received two mosquito complaints already. Wright Patterson Air Force Base will be trapping mosquitoes this year in addition to the health district. The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) will provide testing of mosquitoes for West Nile Virus again this year.
- f. The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency 2015 Annual Survey of Solid & Infectious Waste program and Construction and Demolition Debris program has been scheduled for May 1, 4, and 6, 2015.

6. Epidemiology (Don Brannen, PhD)

- a. Provided Dayton Daily News with the Ohio Teen Death Rate including school-aged children, adolescents and young adults suicide deaths. Also provided suicide deaths by age group in Greene County.
- b. Ebola surveillance coordination with ODH and CDC's Division of Global Migration and Quarantine continues with travelers currently under surveillance. Five have travelers have completed the 21 day surveillance period; three will complete surveillance on 05/09/15, and another traveler (for a total of 9) will arrive on 05/10/15.+
- c. Potato salad made with home-canned potatoes is suspected as the cause in 21 confirmed cases including one death, and 10 more suspected cases of botulism in Lancaster, Fairfield County, as a result of a church potluck dinner. Health officials tested leftover food samples obtained from the trash and interviewed ill patients to determine what common food all of them ate. The Clostridium botulinum bacteria, known as botulism, are found in soil and cause about 145 cases of human illness a year in the U.S., 15% of them are from food. Twenty-two cases of botulism have been reported to date in Ohio as compared to two cases reported in 2014.
