- b. *Mosquito Control*
  - i. As of 10/04/17, mosquitos in 47 Ohio counties tested positive for West Nile Virus (WNV). Greene County had 20 pools test positive for WNV from Bellbrook, Beavercreek, Fairborn, and Sugarcreek Township. All areas were treated with adulticide. There has been one confirmed case of human WNV in Greene County, 21 confirmed human cases in Ohio, and one WNV death in Ohio.
  - ii. There are four confirmed human cases of Zika in Ohio related to overseas travel.
  - iii. This year’s program finalized on 10/15/17.
- c. *Nuisance*
  - i. D. Shontz continues to assist the Shawnee Hills Property Owners Association regarding nuisance and rodent conditions.
