- a. *Food*
  - i. S. Jensen and R. Schairbaum developed an updated food program plan review application.
  - ii. Fifteen food complaints have been received between 04/20/18 and 05/23/18.
  - iii. D. Brannen, T. Myers and R. Schairbaum are investigation a group of foodborne illnesses potentially involving Greene County Fish and Game and the Frisch's in Beavercreek. Investigation is continuing.
- b. *Mosquito Control*
  - i. The remaining funding from the 2017 Environmental Protection Agency grant will be used to purchase supplies for the 2018 season. The health district did not apply for the 2018 grant.
  - ii. Mosquito tapping has begun and the first pools of mosquitos were sent to the Ohio Department of Health laboratory for testing on 05/24/18.
- c. *Plumbing*
  - i. Registered 16 contractors; 225 total for 2018 license year.
  - ii. Sold 248 permits, 857 total for 2018 license year.
  - iii. Reviewed 19 commercial plumbing plans, 58 total for 2018 license year.
  - iv. Made 456 inspections; 1,517 total for 2018 license year.
- e. *Solid Waste*
  - i. Solid waste hauling vehicle registrations were due for renewal in May. One hundred thirty-six vehicles registered for 2018-2019 and must be individually inspected over the next 30-60 days.
- e. *Swimming Pools/Spas*
  - i. Swimming pool licenses were due renewed by 4/30/18. Those not licenses not renewed in a timely manner were assessed proper penalty fees.
