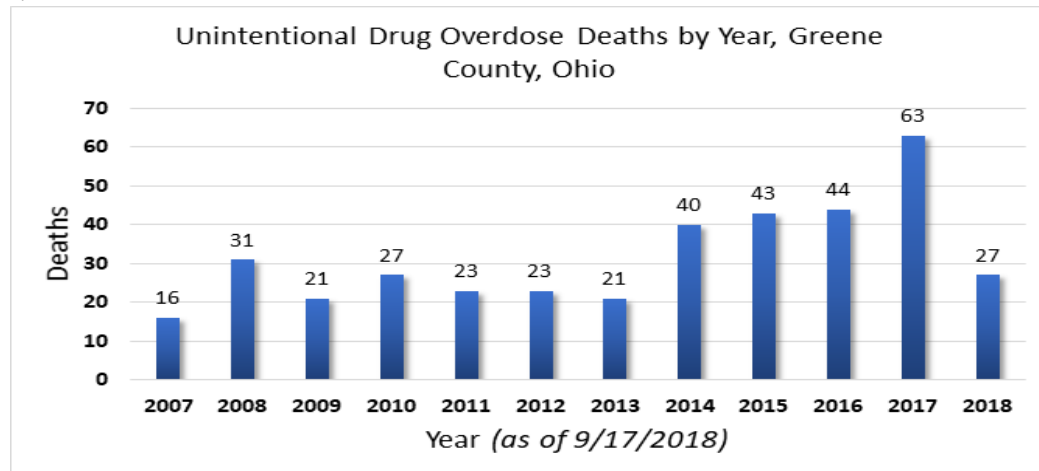




GREENE COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH HEALTH COMMISSIONER'S REPORT September 28, 2018

3. **Early Intervention**

- a. The Early Intervention team received 100% compliance from the state for transition services. Referrals have been low for the months of July and August.

4. **Environmental Health (Jeff Webb)**

- a. *Body Art*
 - i. T. Myers received plans for two new microblading establishments and issued body art establishment licenses for two new establishments.
- b. *Food*
 - i. Donato's Pizza will begin offering Level 1 food training classes on a quarterly instead of yearly basis after attending health district provided training.
 - ii. S. Jensen is developing three new food guidance documents to build consistency in food inspections.
 - iii. C. Propes is developing a new food inspection form.



- iv. Sixteen food complaints were received during this reporting period. Investigations are ongoing.
 - c. *Mosquito Control*
 - i. ODH produces a weekly report of the test results for the State of Ohio and 54 counties have found West Nile Virus (WNV) positive mosquitoes as of the report. Thirty-four human cases and 31 equine cases of WNV have been reported for Ohio. Greene County has submitted 41 pools of mosquitoes this season. Known areas of past mosquito activity in Beavercreek, Bellbrook, Fairborn, Yellow Springs, Xenia and Jamestown continue to have larvicide applied to help curtail mosquito activity every 30 days.
 - ii. Trapping and testing of adult mosquitoes continues each week and an additional WNV positive mosquito pool has been discovered in the Five Points area of Fairborn.
 - d. *Plumbing*
 - i. Seven new registered contractors; 246 total for 2018 license year.
 - ii. Sold 160 permits; 1,441 total for year.
 - iii. Reviewed eight commercial plumbing plans; 81 total for year.
 - iv. Made 354 inspections; 3,070 total for year.
 - e. *Sewage*
 - i. Solid Waste Program survey has been completed. The survey results have not been finalized at this time.
 - f. *Water*
 - i. Special Services team is participating in the update to the Greene County Phase II Stormwater Plan required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Updating the plan will be a major undertaking for the Agencies involved and there are many questions that the EPA would like to see addressed and updated in this plan. The current plan was created in 2012.
5. **Health Education**
- i. On 09/25/18 the health district was notified by the ODH that the Maternal and Child Health Program (MCHP) grant (formerly the Children and Family Health Services grant) for \$85,700 would not be funded for 2019. ODH decided to prioritize funding projects in counties with overall poorer health rankings and counties where the racial disparity in infant mortality rates were the worst. Funding for this grant was \$41,399.00 in 2018.
 - 1. The Baby & Me Tobacco Free and Cribs for Kids programs previously funded through this grant have procured other funding and will continue to operate.
 - 2. The Blessings in a Backpack program has transitioned into a self-sustaining program run by Greenview Schools.
 - 3. The Community Garden project will be taken over by The Ohio State University Extension Office. They are seeking to hire a program manager



with funding from the Greene County Commissioners.
