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COVID-19 test results from June 24 & 25
Two pop-up test sites result in 2.7% positive cases

Dayton, OH—All lab results are in and data is available for the Five Rivers Health Centers COVID-19 testing events on June 24 and 25, in Xenia (Greene County) and Dayton (Montgomery County), respectively.

-In Greene County, 957 individuals were tested on Wednesday, June 24, with nine (9) positive results (.94%) and 948 negative results.

-In Montgomery County, 1,321 individuals were tested on Thursday, June 25, with 53 positive results (4%) and 1,268 negative results.

Individuals who tested positive received a phone call from Five Rivers' Chief Medical Officer, along with information and instructions on self-quarantining, monitoring symptoms and seeing a health care provider. Those who tested negative were mailed a letter stating that their test result was negative. Everyone tested was encouraged to discuss the test and their individual results with their primary care provider.

"Five Rivers Health Centers was happy to partner with the Governor's COVID-19 Minority Health Strike Force and the Ohio National Guard to provide this free testing to more than 2,000 of our neighbors in Montgomery and Greene counties. It was an honor for us to serve so many residents in a very short period of time," said Gina McFarlane-El, CEO of Five Rivers Health Centers.
