3. **Environmental Health**

a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*

- i. The team continues to work remotely, conducting inspections and assisting in the investigation of COVID-related complaints, particularly those involving food operations where it has been reported that employees are working sick, not quarantining, etc.
- ii. License renewal letters and applications for the 2021 licensure year have been mailed out to all retail establishment and food service operations, mobile food operations and vending locations.

b. *Body Art*

- i. All body art establishments have been licensed for 2021.

c. *Sewage*

- i. The sewage system variance for a new sewage system on Curtis Lane in New Jasper Township was approved. The variance involved using an existing easement as part of the area for the new leach lines for the new sewage system. The design has been approved.
- ii. The team is working through all the new 2021 registrations for sewage system installers, service providers and septage haulers to ensure that all the contractors working in the sewage program are property registered for this year. The registration process is a joint venture between the health district and the Ohio Department of Health (ODH). The 2021 registration process is much slower in 2021 since ODH team members are working remotely and only one person is in the office at a time.
- iii. The joint project between the health district and the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission is progressing. Each agency is discussing the staff requirements for

insurance to cover the intern while they work for each agency. The project will try to locate and plot existing septic tanks using GPS technology.

- d. *Solid Waste*
 - i. The revised Greene County Solid Waste Plan is in the process of being ratified by the Greene County Commissioners and the local city, village, and township administrations during the month of January. Once the plan has been ratified by these parties, the plan will be submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency for final approval.
 - ii. The 2021 Solid Waste licenses were issued for the Waste Management Transfer Station and the Xenia Construction and Demolition Debris landfill.
- e. *Private Water Systems*
 - i. Jackie Gruza is working with all the local water haulers to ensure that each water hauler is registered and inspected for 2021. The water haulers provide potable water to homes and businesses that do not have sufficient well water and must rely on water storage tanks for their water supply. The list of approved water haulers in Greene County is sent to ODH each year to add to the statewide list of water haulers for emergency planning use.

4. **Maternal Child Health**

- a. *Early Intervention*
 - i. The program received “Meets” requirements, the highest possible rating, for the FFY19/SFY20 Annual Performance Report and Determination. Detailed information regarding how this is determined is available by submitting a request to Pam Hamer, Early Intervention Program Manager. This information will be available on the Ohio Early Intervention website soon. Referrals continue to average around 25 per month with a little bit of an increase for January.
- b. *Early Childhood Home Visiting:*
 - i. Earl Childhood Home Visiting is currently at full capacity serving 51 families. There are currently three alternate families on the waiting list.
 - ii. The incentive and retention project for January and February is to supplement families with diapers and wipes, providing an opportunity to have powerful conversations about predictable routines.
- c. *Baby Me and Tobacco Free*
 - i. Two new pregnant moms enrolled in Baby & Me Tobacco Free during this reporting period.
