# GREENE COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT March 26, 2021

## 1. Foundational Capabilities

### a. Administration

- i. At the Annual meeting of the District Advisory Council the members selected officers and re-appointed Angelia Mickle and Jane Clifton to the board of health. The members received the Annual Report from the district and approved the health district budgeted amounts.
- ii. The Planning and Finance Committee of the board of health met to review and approve the 2020 End of Year Report for the health district and the 2022 Budget.

### b. Public Health Emergency Preparedness

- i. The health district continues to respond to COVID-19. The number of people testing positive began to decline once vaccination began. The health district switched to using the Vaccine Management System on March 8, 2021. Other vaccine providers who had registration systems in place are still working to integrate with the statewide system. Kindergarten-12<sup>th</sup> grade teachers who wanted to be vaccinated were vaccinated by Premier Health, Kroger, and the health district. Twenty-one hours per week of vaccination clinics are being held weekly by the health district.

### 3. **Environmental Health**

- a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*
  - i. R. Schairbaum and M. Straight conducted the first food training course of 2021. A total of 19 students attended the ServSafe Manager Certification course on March 15 and 22. Two students retested for the ServSafe exam. The Fraternal Order of Eagles Lodge hosted the ServSafe Manager Certification course.
- b. *Sewage*
  - i. The new 2021 registrations for sewage system installers, service providers and septage haulers have been processed and all registrations are current. The registration process is a joint venture between the health district and ODH.
- c. *Solid Waste*
  - i. The Greene County Solid Waste Plan for 2021 has been ratified by the jurisdictions in Greene County and the plan is considered ratified by Greene County and is ready to present to the Environmental Protection Agency. A Solid Waste Policy Committee was held on March 31, 2021 to finalize all the actions necessary for the final plan approval for the next five years.
- d. *Public Health Nuisances*
  - i. J. Gruza continues to work with Bath Township and the Greene County Prosecutor's Office regarding an abandoned property on Bath Road. The house has not been occupied for more than five years and the inside of the house has been heavily damaged by raccoons and other animals. The owner does not live in Ohio and has not responded to health district orders to repair the property. The township would like to demolish the house.
- e. *Mosquito*
  - i. Clarke Mosquito Products has delayed replacement of liquid adulticide products. Clarke Mosquito Products has been informed by the EPA that some of the plastic containers that adulticide products are shipped and stored in could contaminate the product with per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS or PFOS) chemicals.
