2. **Environmental Health**

- a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*
 - i. General Services conducted a ServSafe Manager Certification food training on May 10 and May 17. A Person in Charge (PIC) Certification course was held on May 18. T. Myers, C. Propes, K. Ray, and K. Steward were the instructors for the courses. A total of 20 students attended the training courses.
 - ii. On May 18 C. Propes, R. Schairbaum, and J. Webb, conducted a joint inspection at a bar and grill regarding recalcitrance by the owner to comply with the Ohio Food Code. The owner was given until June 15 to get all violations corrected to avoid potential enhanced enforcement action.
 - iii. On May 16 inspections were conducted at the Blessing of the Bikes event conducted at Kil Kare Raceway.
- b. *Body Art*
 - i. C. Propes approved plans for a new body art establishment and is also involved in negotiations with the United States Air Force (USAF) at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base involving plan submission, licensure, and inspections of a body art establishment on base. This request was made by the USAF because they do not have a body art regulatory program and associated authority. This is being reviewed by our legal counsel before the health district moves forward with this request.
- c. *Campground*
 - i. On May J. Webb and R. Schairbaum attended the Tecumseh Council Boy Scouts award ceremony at Camp Birch. The health district received the North Star Award for the efforts provided to the Boy Scouts during the pandemic last year that enabled them to have a successful Camp Jamboree event. Not a single person contracted COVID because of attending/camping during the event.
- e. *Vector Control*
 - i. The Mosquito Control Program has begun for 2021. Larvicide is being applied to known mosquito breeding areas and a few complaints have been received.
 - ii. S. Adams and M. Isaacson attended the mosquito sprayer rodeo in Columbus on 05/25/2021. Both mosquito sprayers were tested, inspected, and certified for use during the 2021 mosquito season.
 - iii. Tick information was supplied to the local media reminding everyone that it is tick season and to be watchful of ticks attaching to people and pets.
