### 3. **Environmental Health**

- a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*
  - i. R. Schairbaum and C. Propes continue to work with a sports bar to address outstanding violations that remain unresolved. R. Schairbaum and C. Propes conducted a consultative visit on 06/10/2021 and the noted violations must be corrected by 07/01/2021.
- b. *Sewage*
  - i. M. Isaacson met with two Bath Township Trustees at a site on Clearcreek Trail in Bath Township. The drainage in the road ditch is not draining properly and may be affecting individual sewage systems upslope of the problem area. The Greene County Engineer’s Office and Soil and Water Conservation District will be involved in finding a solution.
- c. *Mosquito*
  - i. The mosquito control program continues as normal for 2021. The program has had a slow start due to a low number of complaints this year. Larvicide is being applied to known problem areas and neighborhoods.
  - ii. The drone continues to be used to take fly over pictures of the completed installations of sewage systems and is being used to respond to mosquito complaints and observe problem areas. There is some discussion about purchasing a large drone to apply

larvicide and adulticide for the mosquito program. Grant funds from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) would be used for purchasing the drone.

- d. *Solid Waste*
  - i. The solid waste hauling vehicle registrations are being processed, vehicles are being inspected and plans have been made to schedule the inspections of vehicles from large companies to ensure that all standards are met for the vehicles.
- e. *Public Water Systems*
  - i. 05/27/2021 J. Webb, M. Isaacson, R. Schairbaum, S. Collins and D. Rasper were involved in a web conference regarding the treatment and filtration of a nursing home facility plumbing system due to a possible case of Legionella. The call included representatives from the facility and their parent company as well as the Ohio Department of Health (ODH). ODH has assumed the lead on the investigation and the health district is aiding as requested.

#### 4. **Maternal Child Health**

- a. *Early Intervention*
  - i. P. Hamer had been meeting with Four Oaks Early Intervention to develop procedures that mirror the state guidance for transitioning to offering in-person visits as an option for service delivery. Virtual services will also remain an option for families moving forward particularly for those families where scheduling is a challenge as this worked great this past year. Service coordinators will begin discussing with families the need for either virtual or in-person services (Four Oaks Services) to meet the Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP) outcomes at IFSP meetings beginning on 07/06/2021. Per state guidance, service coordinators do not need to begin meeting in person until at least August 31<sup>st</sup>. The in-person procedures developed take into consideration families who may or may not be vaccinated, health of children and families particularly those who are at high risk due to medical conditions. In addition, iPads have been purchased for service coordinators to take into homes so the family can have their own device allowing additional space between service coordinators and caregivers.
