1. Foundational Capabilities

- a. *Administration*
 - i. The health district circulated distributed the draft 2022-2024 Strategic Plan. The strategic issues to be addressed in the next period are community health, community preparedness, addressing barriers to optimal health, reaccreditation, and workforce development. The strategic plan provides a planned approach and clear picture of what the organization will achieve in the next three years. Public health works to improve the health of individuals and families. and strengthens communities by promoting healthy lifestyles, preventing and controlling infectious disease and injury, and protecting health from disease threats in our environment.

b. *COVID-19 Response*

- i. The Greene County Area Command is meeting monthly to make any adjustments to the incident objectives. Health district activities include disease investigation, contact tracing, administering vaccines and providing information to the community when they need it. Additional support was needed from the Medical Reserve Corps and ProLink through the State of Ohio while cases are surging. The Delta variant is highly contagious. People in Greene County who are falling ill have more severe symptoms than the previous dominant variant. Hospitalized people are younger.
- ii. Public health nurses have coordinated with local school districts to interrupt disease transmission and mitigate clusters within schools. Two meetings with superintendents have occurred. The first meeting was to provide cases that occur in children, Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome in Children (MIS-C), isolation and quarantine authority and guidance. The second meeting was to discuss contact tracing.

3. **Environmental Health**

a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*

- i. During the past month, environmental team members performed inspections for the Greene County Fair, Fairborn Sweet Corn Festival, and some minor food temporary operations. To date, a total of 48 temporary food licenses have been issued for the 2021 food licensure year.
- ii. R. Schairbaum and C. Propes continue to work with the Bellbrook Fire Department and a local sports bar involving several violations. Bellbrook Fire Department was involved due to an unclean hood, stack, and filters. At a follow-up inspection meeting on 08/03/2021, the fire threat issues had been resolved and nearly all the food code issues were resolved. The health district established a time limit of 08/27/2021 for the owner to submit a cleaning schedule and plan of action to complete the remaining unresolved violations/pest control issues.
- iii. J. Webb and R. Schairbaum met with representatives of the Fairborn Building Department. This was a meet & greet opportunity for us to meet the new chief building official and other employees, and to see how our two agencies can work together and to build a positive, collaborative working relationship.

b. *Housing*

- i. Environmental team is working on three separate housing issues for cleanup. Two in Yellow Springs and one in Jamestown.

c. *Mosquito*

- i. The health district was notified on 08/17/2021, that four (4) mosquito pools from Greene County tested positive for West Nile Virus (WNV). These mosquitoes were

trapped between 08/01 and 08/05/2021 in the western part of Bellbrook. The area of the positive mosquitoes has been treated with larvicide and a press release was sent out with the information about the positive test and mosquito control activities.

- ii. Trapping of adult mosquitoes and application of larvicide in breeding areas continues throughout the county. Forty-nine (49) Ohio counties have trapped WNV positive mosquitoes. Clark County has 19 positive pools and Warren County has two (2) positive pools so far in 2021.
- iii. Ohio currently has one human case of WNV. The human case is from Jefferson County. Ohio has no animal or horse cases of WNV so far in 2021.
- iv. The drone is being used to identify mosquito breeding sites on a regular basis.
- v. J. Webb is studying to take the drone pilot test. Champaign County will come to visit and observe the drone activity.

d. *Sewage*

- i. Each new sewage system that is installed has pictures taken with the drone to be placed in the records for that address with the owner's permission.

e. *Solid Waste*

- i. The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Solid Waste Program survey was scheduled for 08/25 and 08/26/2021. This was an in-person survey conducted with Ohio EPA personnel. As part of the survey, the Cedarville Closed Landfill was inspected during the annual Ohio EPA water sampling of the landfill's monitor wells on 08/26/2021.

e. *Swimming Pools*

- i. J. Gruza is helping M. Straight with a swimming pool nuisance at a local hotel in Xenia. The pool is not being maintained and is causing mosquito and other nuisance issues.
