1. Foundational Capabilities

3. Environmental Health

- a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*
 - i. J. Webb and R. Schairbaum met with Yellow Springs Public Works Director Johnnie Burns and with NIC representatives (via Zoom) to discuss the new building department, and to meet the new NIC inspectors. NIC is a private company providing inspection services on behalf of Yellow Springs. This meeting was to introduce ourselves and establish how our agencies can work together within the community to address various inspection/needs/issues involving our agencies.

- ii. Representatives with a local bar and grill appeared before J. Webb for a Director’s Meeting to discuss the operation of their facility and food licensure status. Mutual agreements were made, and a follow-up inspection will be conducted by C. Propes and R. Schairbaum on 12/07/2021.
 - iii. Since the previous BOH report, General and Special Services team members performed inspections at the Haunted Classic, Vintage Market Days, and several individual events where food operations had a temporary food license. The only remaining event for the remainder of the calendar year is Xenia Hometown Christmas.
 - iv. Darrell McGuire and Kayle Nassif from BGI (Baldwin) Group visited our agency for two days. This was to learn how HDIS is integrated into our actual field inspections and how this integrates with the HDIS program. Also conducted a roundtable meeting with the General/Special Services teams and N. Crawford to discuss all the HDIS modules Environmental Health uses and how the HDIS program can be improved to increase accuracy and efficiency.
