### 3. **Environmental Health**

#### a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*

- i. R. Schairbaum and K. Ray taught the first day of the ServSafe Manager Certification Course on 06/06/2022 for 16 individuals. The second date, 06/13/2022, of the course had to be rescheduled due to illness for 06/28/2022. Those students who could not attend the second day will be permitted to attend the October course.
- ii. On 06/15/2022, the food court at The Mall at Fairfield Commons experienced a power outage. On 06/16/2022, R. Schairbaum and A. Glascoe inspected all the food court tenants to assess food safety. Since the power outage lasted for 14 hours, all time and temperature control foods (TCS) were ordered to be discarded and fresh TCS food delivered before the food operations were permitted to reopen. The coolers/freezers were also inspected to verify that proper holding temperatures were achieved. A representative from mall management accompanied the inspectors during this process and were a tremendous help during the inspection process.
- iii. The Ohio Department of Agriculture will be performing a survey of retail food establishments the week of 08//-08/26/2022 at the health district.
- iv. The following festivals were inspected since last month's report: Hamvention, Creek Classic, SummerFest Xenia, Jamestown Street Fair, and Yellow Springs Gay Pride Parade.

#### b. *Swimming Pools*

- i. The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) performed a swimming pool and campground survey on 05/23-05/24/2022.
- ii. The health district team has been busy opening and inspecting the outdoor swimming pools and spas.

#### c. *Solid Waste*

- i. The solid waste hauling vehicle registrations are being processed, vehicles are being inspected, and plans have been made to schedule the inspections of vehicles from large companies to ensure that all the standards are met for these vehicles.

#### d. Mosquito

- i. The mosquito control program began routine sampling in known problem areas. So far, the health district has had ZERO mosquitoes positive for West Nile Virus (WNV) in Greene County.
- ii. In preparation for the Independence Day festivities, the health district conducted spraying operations the last week of June to lessen WNV risk and abate nuisance mosquitoes.
