i. *Media*

1. Wright State University Guardian newspaper interviewed S. Webb regarding COVID-19 and Monkeypox.

ii. Monkeypox- no reports have been received for Greene County. Twenty-five doses of JYNNEOS vaccine were received.

3. **Environmental Health**

a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*

i. R. Schairbaum and A. Glascoe taught a Person-In-Charge (PIC) Certification course on 08/17/2022 at Cedarville University. There were 33 students in attendance.

- ii. A. Glascoe, C. Propes, K. Ray, and M. Straight prepared for the Ohio Department of Agriculture (ODA) food survey by performing mock survey inspections with R. Schairbaum.
 - iii. Beginning 08/22/2022, ODA performed both administrative and field survey of the retail food establishment food program. The survey was completed 08/26/2022 An exit interview was conducted with J. Webb and R. Schairbaum.
 - iv. During the past month, the Environmental team performed inspections for the Greene County Fair, Fairborn Bluegrass & Brew, Fairborn Sweet Corn Festival, Bellbrook Lion’s Summerfest, and some food temporary operations. To date, a total of 80 temporary food licenses have been issued for the 2022 food licensure year.
- b. *Mosquito/Vector Control*
- i. Trapping of adult mosquitoes continues throughout the county. To date, no mosquitos have tested positive for West Nile Virus (WNV) in Greene County. Mosquito spraying has been conducted monthly since the end of June and will continue through at least September—possibly longer depending on weather.
- c. *Rabies*
- i. A dead bat was found by a resident and submitted to the health district for rabies testing. The bat was found to be rabies positive. After consulting with the Ohio Department of Health (ODH), it was determined that the family dog was considered an exposure. The animal was up to date on vaccinations and was placed on 45-day quarantine.
- d. *Solid Waste*
- i. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Solid Waste Program survey has been scheduled for 08/24-08/25/2022. This will be an in-person survey conducted with Ohio EPA personnel.
 - ii. S. Adams and J. Gruza attended a meeting with Xenia Construction & Demolition Debris and Ohio EPA to discuss discovery of significant leachate outbreak and elevated monitoring well readings.
