- i. 08/31/2022 the health district began providing vaccine to identified at-risk clients.



2. **Environmental Health**

a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*

- i. The Environmental Health Retail Food Establishment program was surveyed by the Ohio Department of Agriculture (ODA) the week of 08/22/2022. The exit interview was conducted on 09/02/2022. All team members passed their field inspections, and ODA stated that the health district runs an excellent program. Please see the included survey results.
- ii. The team has performed inspections for the Wright State University Fall Festival, Cedarville Cedar Fest, Xenia Old Fashion Days, Beaver Creek Popcorn Festival, Jamestown Fall Festival, Old Timers Festival, and food temporary operations. To date, a total of 114 temporary food licenses have been issued for the 2022 food licensure year.
- iii. On 09/30/2022 the health district hosted the Southwest Ohio Food RoundTable meeting with numerous county and state agency representatives in attendance.

b. *Mosquito/Vector Control*

- i. The Mosquito Control program has wrapped up for the year. Greene County had zero West Nile Virus-positive mosquito cases. The last planned spraying route (originally scheduled for 09/28/2022) has been cancelled due to the sharply cooler temperatures.
- ii. The health district submitted three bats to Ohio Department of Health for rabies testing. All three tested negative.
- iii. After a referral by the Xenia City Manager, J. Gruza is working with a roach and bed bug infestation at an apartment complex on North Detroit Street. Both buildings in the complex are having pest problems but are under new management who seem eager to get a handle on the problem.

c. *Solid Waste*

- i. The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) completed the Solid Waste Program Survey in August. The EPA team member highlighted several practical suggestions for improving our inspection reports. The health district remains on the "Approved List."

d. *Housing*

- i. In cooperation with a new demolition program administered by Greene County Department of Development, D. Shontz and J. Marks obtained aerial photographs with our drone as "before" pictures.

e. *Swimming Pools*

- i. All outdoor pool inspections have been completed for the season. For the remainder of the calendar year only indoor pools will be inspected.
