GREENE COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT October 28, 2022

1. Foundational Capabilities

a. Accreditation

- i. Eleven employees completed the Quality Improvement Fundamentals training. The TechCred grant was utilized to offer this training and application has been made for another round of funding.
- ii. Our Community Health Assessment survey was finalized, and the first wave of surveys will be sent out 11/01/2022.

b. Emergency Preparedness

- i. The Greene County Emergency Preparedness Committee met on 10/20/2022. K. Caudill co-chaired the meeting. Information was shared regarding current hospitalizations for Covid-19 and other diseases of concern. Everyone is encouraged to be up to date on Covid vaccination and get a shot for influenza.
- ii. Covid-19:
 - a. Local libraries and senior centers received posters and booster card notices for the Covid-19 bivalent vaccine.
 - b. Greene County residents are encouraged to get their flu shot and stay up to date on their Covid-19 immunizations. Community transmission levels are expected to fluctuate.
 - c. On 10/20/2022 the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices updated their recommendations for the 2023 childhood and adult immunization schedules which is commonly updated. The committee routinely makes recommendations for the use of vaccines, while school-entry vaccination requirements are established in State laws.

3. Environmental Health

a. Food Establishment/Food Service

- i. A ServSafe Manager Certification course was taught on 10/17 and 10/24/2022 by R. Schairbaum, C. Propes and A. Glascoe. This is the last scheduled food training course for 2022. The training schedule for 2023 will be generated and posted by 12/01/2022.
- ii. On 10/27/22, R. Schairbaum hosted two inspectors from Miami County Public Health to tour Jeet India Restaurant and become more educated regarding food preparations for Indian dishes and their operations. The owner of Jeet India, Mr. Singh, was very accommodating, and the health district appreciates his cooperation in this endeavor!
- iii. Since the previous report, the Environmental team has performed inspections at: Spring Valley Potato Festival, Central State University Homecoming, Yellow Springs Street Fair, Harvest on the Main, Fairborn Halloween Fest, Haunted Classic, and several individual events where food operations had a temporary food license. There are only two scheduled events left on the 2022 festival season calendar.

b. Sewage

- i. The annual Sewage Contractor meeting will be 12/09/2022. This meeting provides contractors and environmental health specialists the opportunity to get up to six hours of continuing education units. The agenda features speakers from the health district, Greene County Department of Development, Ohio Utility Protection Services, and a representative of a sewage equipment manufacturer.
- ii. New sewage system inspection forms have been drafted to simplify the inspection process and provide an easier-to-read report for the homeowner.
- iii. The health district team is working with the Ohio Department of Health to address a problem with a newly installed sewage system in Beaver Creek Township. The landscaping company trenched through the brand-new leaching bed with irrigation piping. The system had not yet been given a final inspection, and approval of the system is being withheld if/until a solution is found.

c. Water

- i. Prosecution is being pursued through City of Fairborn against a landlord who violated health district orders by not providing a potable water supply to the tenant.

d. Solid Waste

- i. S. Adams received one-on-one instruction from Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and completed licensing of all solid waste facilities within Ohio EPA's eBiz system.

e. Rabies

- i. A raccoon and a bat were submitted to Ohio Department of Health labs for rabies testing. Both were negative.

4. **Maternal Child Health**

- a. *Early Intervention (EI)*
 - i. Families are encouraged to complete the state family survey. This is an opportunity for families to share how their Early Intervention experience has been a benefit to their family. In addition, there are questions about knowing their rights, respect, learning about child development and how to help their child grow and be successful. Greene County response mid- September was one of the top ten percentages. Final response percentages will be sent out in early November. Lastly, the program will be focusing marketing efforts to childcare centers and participating in the Trunk or Treat event through Greene County Job and Family Services.
- b. *Early Childhood Home Visiting*
 - i. The Healthy Families America Home Visiting team has expanded to four home visitors and the Nurse Family Partnership has two nurse home visitors. I. Barnett and T. Sparks have been approved as home visitors after completion of over 21 hours of training.
