1. Foundational Capabilities

a. Accreditation

3. **Environmental Health**

- a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*
 - i. R. Schairbaum and J. Webb completed the second day of the ServSafe class. A total of 19 students were in attendance and one student retested. To date, the environmental team has taught eight Person In Charge (PIC)/Manager Certification food training courses for 155 students. Three students needed to retest, and the health district proctored two ServSafe exams. ServSafe Manager Certification Courses are complete for the year. A PIC training class will be held on 11/28/2022.
 - ii. R. Schairbaum and A. Glascoe attended a meeting at the Greene County Fairgrounds with a representative from the World A'Fair organization. This three-day festival has moved to the fairgrounds for 2023. The International Festival dates are 05/05-05/07/2023.
 - iii. Since the previous report, Environmental team members performed inspections at the Haunted Classic, Vintage Market Days, Wilberforce University Homecoming, and several individual events where food operations had a temporary food license. The only remaining event for the 2022 calendar year is The Christmas Station, Xenia.
- b. *Body Art*
 - i. Body Art Establishment license renewal letters were mailed out to all Body Art Establishments for the 2023 licensure year. Applications can begin to be processed on or after November 1st. The deadline for licensure is December 31st, after which a 25% penalty fee will be assessed.
- c. *Sewage*
 - i. The Ohio Department of Health's (ODH) scheduled survey of the health district's sewage program was postponed due to staffing shortages at ODH. The survey has not been rescheduled yet but is expected no sooner than Spring 2023.
 - ii. The Greene County Sewage System Contractor meeting is scheduled for 12/09/2022. The meeting will be held at the Media Room on Ledbetter Road in Xenia. Contractors from several counties in the region have been invited to attend.
