3. **Environmental Health**

a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*

- ii. A total of 32 students have attended the Person in Charge (PIC)/ServSafe training. Four attendees sat for the ServSafe exam proctored by R. Schairbaum. Two students retested.
- iii. A total of 47 plans for brick-and-mortar food operations and mobile food operations have been submitted.
- iv. The following festivals were inspected: Xenia Spring Fling, World A’Fair, Hamvention, Jamestown Street Fair, and single temporary license events.

b. *Body Art*

- i. A total of eight body art establishments have been submitted.

c. *Swimming Pools/Campgrounds*

- i. License renewal is continuing for swimming pools/spas and recreational vehicle parks. A total of four pools have yet to renew their license for 2023 and pay the 25% penalty fee. All recreational vehicle campgrounds renewed their license fees for 2023.
- ii. 05/10/2023 K. Ray and M. Straight conducted a swimming pool/spa training course for public pool operators at Greene County Public Health.
- iii. J. Webb and R. Schairbaum are preparing for the upcoming Ohio Department of Health (ODH) survey of Greene County’s public pools and recreational vehicle camp programs to be conducted in June.

d. *Mosquito*

- i. The colder, wet weather for this month has delayed the need to begin our mosquito program. Warmer, dryer weather is expected next month. D. Shontz and J. Marks took the mosquito sprayers for calibration to Groveport on 05/23/2023. Both mosquito sprayers were tested, inspected, and certified for use during the 2023 mosquito season.
- ii. A former garage in the City of Beavercreek was abandoned by its owner and is in foreclosure. The rear of the garage contains approximately 200 old tires. Greene County Public Health will monitor and treat with larvicide to prevent mosquito problems until the city can abate the problem.

- i. J. Gruza began the annual inspection of trash trucks. There has been an increase in the number of registered trash trucks this year, with Allied Waste tripling the number of registered trucks to 65.
