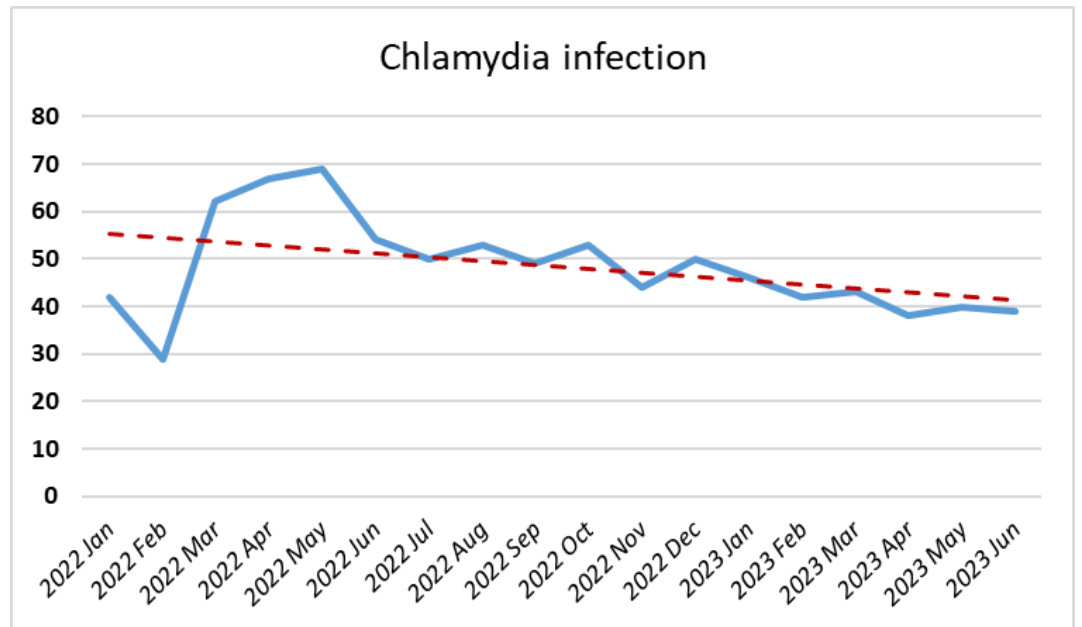
1. Foundational Capabilities

a. Administration

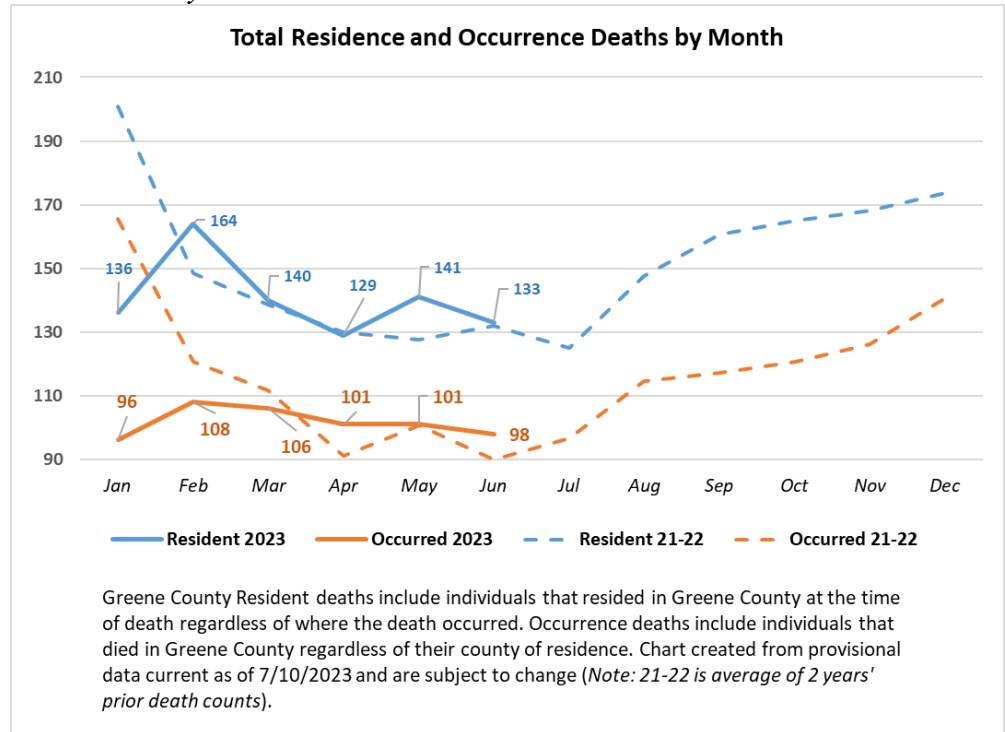

3. Environmental Health

a. *Food Establishment/Food Service*

i. The following festivals were inspected since last month's Board of Health report: Yellow Springs Gay Pride Parade, Fairborn Block Party, Yellow Springs Fourth of July, Beavercreek Fourth of July, Sonnycalb Fireworks, Red, White & Blue Xenia Block Party.

ii. J. Gruza, A. Straight, R. Schairbaum and J. Webb are working on a significant mouse infestation at a local retail store. General Services is involved from the retail food establishment perspective due to their food license. J. Webb, S. Adams and J. Gruza will continue to assess this situation from a public health nuisance perspective.

- b. *Swimming Pools*
 - i. The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) swimming pools, spas and campground program survey exit interview was conducted 07/07/23 with J. Webb and R. Schairbaum. General Services is awaiting the final survey reports from ODH.
- c. *Mosquito*
 - i. The mosquito control program continues with new trapping locations being identified. Seven pools of mosquitos have been submitted for testing.
 - ii. Greene County Public Health was invited to present at an Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) webinar on 07/25/23. D. Shontz provided an interesting demonstration of the current use of our drones for nuisance and sewage work and highlighted the potential possibilities of using drones for the mosquito program. Ohio EPA has been considering our proposal to apply for funding for a new drone for mosquito treatment applications.
- d. *Solid Waste*
 - i. There have been preliminary reports that Waste Management is considering re-opening their transfer station in Fairborn. They have maintained their permit and receive quarterly inspections, despite having not received any waste transfers for several years.
