



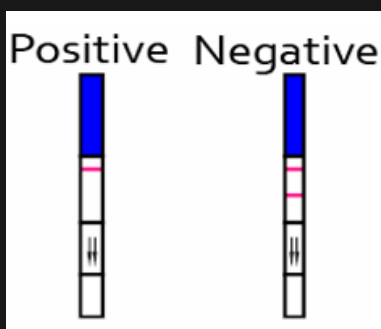

WHAT IS FENTANYL?

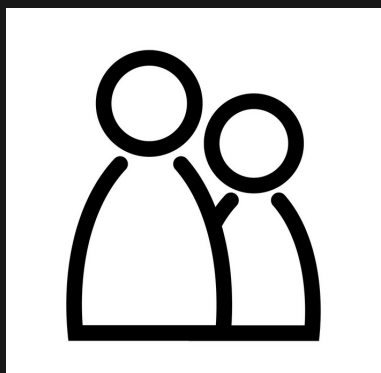
Fentanyl is a synthetic (man-made) opioid 50 times more potent than heroin and 100 times more potent than morphine. Non-pharmaceutical fentanyl is frequently referred to as illicitly manufactured fentanyl (IMF). IMF is often mixed with heroin, meth, and/or cocaine or pressed into counterfeit pills—with or without the user’s knowledge.

TEST YOUR SUPPLY



SafeTrade aims to supply individuals with free fentanyl test strips so they can be as informed as possible before consuming. Our test strips are sensitive not only to fentanyl but can also detect many fentanyl analogues including acetyl fentanyl and carfentanil. NEVER USE ALONE



If you have no choice but to use alone, call **1-800-484-3731** You will be asked for your location, about any allergies, or medical conditions. An operator will then stay on the line with you while you use. If you do not respond after a set amount of time after you've used, the operator will notify emergency services of your location, allergies/conditions, and possible overdose. <http://neverusealone.com/>

GO SLOW



Fentanyl acts FAST. When you take a drug, start with a very small amount to test the strength. Don't slam it. You can always take more, but you can never take less. If you inject drugs, inject a little bit first and wait 20 seconds to see how strong it is. If it feels off, consider not using it or using less than planned. Be sure someone with you has naloxone. <https://www.goslow.org/>
