Pfizer Booster Doses Available at Greene County Public Health

XENIA, OH – Greene County Public Health is offering Pfizer booster doses beginning this week at their clinics offered on Thursdays from 2:00-3:30pm and on Fridays from 8:30-11:30am. This is the only brand currently authorized as a booster. There will also be a drive through clinic held on Wednesday, October 13 from 9am – 4pm at the Fairborn Fire Station #2 located at 2200 Commerce Center Blvd., in Fairborn.

The Pfizer/Comirnaty COVID-19 vaccine is available for the following populations at least six months after completion of the primary Pfizer series, meaning at least six months after the second dose was administered:

- **People 65 years and older or residents in long-term care settings SHOULD** receive a booster shot.
- **People ages 50 to 64 with certain underlying medical conditions SHOULD** receive a booster shot.
- **People ages 18 to 49 with certain underlying medical conditions MAY** receive a booster shot based on their individual benefits and risks. The CDC has indicated that this is a determination made by the vaccine recipient, but those eligible are encouraged to talk to their healthcare providers if they have any questions.
- **People age 18 and older who are at increased risk for COVID-19 exposure and transmission because of their job or living in an institutional setting MAY** receive a booster shot based on their individual benefits and risks. The CDC has indicated that this is a determination made by the vaccine recipient.
- It is considered a booster if you had a normal immune response during your first or second dose. Immuno-Compromised individuals typically did not so for those individuals it is called a Third Dose.

There are many opportunities in Greene County to be vaccinated, including walk-in and scheduled appointments at your local public health office, local pharmacies and doctor's offices. There is an ample supply of vaccines for boosters, as well as first and second doses, for Greene Countians. Eligible booster recipients will be asked to attest they have one of the qualifying conditions, but the specific proof will not be required.
