## Greene County Community Health Survey Begins Next Week

**XENIA, OH** – Next week, ‘Growing Healthy Together Greene County’ will begin its survey of Greene County residents as part of a community health assessment process. Growing Healthy Together Greene County is working closely with the Hospital Council of Northwest Ohio and researchers at the University of Toledo to conduct the survey. Over the next two months, 3,200 Greene County residents will be randomly selected to participate in a survey of adults ages 19 years and older. Residents of Greene County who are randomly selected are urged to complete and return this important survey.

The anonymous survey asks participants to answer questions about general health, risk and protective health factors, and access to health care. These answers will create a snapshot of the health of Greene County. The results will guide many public and private agencies in their program planning over the next several years by identifying key health problems. The final community health assessment report will be published in the summer of 2023 at which time the results will be used to prioritize needs and create a community health improvement plan.
