GCPH Responds to Demand for COVID-19 Vaccine with Additional Clinics

XENIA, OH – Greene County Public Health (GCPH) officials announced that their hours for COVID-19 clinics are expanding again to meet the demand by the public to obtain the vaccine. **The new dates and times are Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays, 8:30-11:30am and 1:30-3:30pm, at the GCPH main office located at 360 Wilson Drive in Xenia.**

There will also be a vaccine clinic on Friday, October 8, 2021 from 9:00-11:00am at Yellow Springs High School, 420 E. Enon Road in Yellow Springs. All brands will be available for 1st/2nd doses. Pfizer 3rd doses and booster doses will also be available. **Appointments are required at this location; no walk-ins will be accepted.**

Finally, there is a drive thru clinic scheduled for Wednesday, October 13 from 9:00am – 4:00pm at the Fairborn Fire Station #2 located at 2200 Commerce Center Blvd., in Fairborn. This clinic will offer Moderna and Pfizer vaccines for 1st and 2nd doses. Third doses and Booster doses of Pfizer ONLY are for those who qualify at this time. All those attending this drive thru clinic must enter Commerce Center Boulevard from Trebein Road to be admitted to the clinic site.

Those who can receive a third or booster dose include:

- **People 65 years and older or residents in long-term care settings SHOULD receive a booster shot.**
- **People ages 50 to 64 with certain underlying medical conditions SHOULD receive a booster shot.**
- **People ages 18 to 49 with certain underlying medical conditions MAY receive a booster shot based on their individual benefits and risks. The CDC has indicated that this is a determination made by the vaccine recipient, but those eligible are encouraged to talk to their healthcare providers if they have any questions.**
- **People age 18 and older who are at increased risk for COVID-19 exposure and transmission because of their job or living in an institutional setting MAY receive a booster shot based on their individual benefits and risks. The CDC has indicated that this is a determination made by the vaccine recipient.**

- Immunocompromised individuals who meet certain, specific criteria and received an mRNA vaccine (either Pfizer or Moderna), are already eligible for a third dose in their main primary series to strengthen their initial vaccine response. This additional dose should not be confused with a booster dose, which is used to strengthen waning immunity and bolster protection against serious outcomes including hospitalization and death.

Appointments are strongly preferred, and all clinic dates and times are subject to change. Appointments can be scheduled by visiting <https://gettheshot.coronavirus.ohio.gov> For ALL scheduled clinics, please bring:

- your COVID-19 vaccination record card
- a copy of your insurance card (if applicable)
- your driver's license
- a parent or guardian to accompany recipients age 12-17
